PHARMACY PROGRAMS ADMINISTRATOR - INTEGRATION GUIDE

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INTRODUCTION

The Pharmacy Programs Administrator (PPA) has been working with software vendors to develop integration between the PPA Portal and software commonly used by pharmacists in order to provide you with a more streamlined claiming process.

The PPA Portal has initially been updated to support direct integration with software for the following claim types:

- MedsCheck Service Claims
- Diabetes MedsCheck Service Claims
- Home Medicines Review Service Claims
- COVID-19 Vaccination in Community Pharmacy (CVCP) Claims
- Residential Medication Management Reviews (RMMR) Initial Service Claims
- Opioid Dependence Treatment (ODT) Community Pharmacy Program Staged Supply and Injection claims
- National Immunisation Program Vaccinations in Pharmacy (NIPVIP) Program Claims.

Integration functionality for additional programs and claim types will be developed over time.

Your software vendor will advise when their integration with the PPA Portal is ready for use and will provide you with software specific user guides and FAQs.


This User Guide outlines how to generate the API key that your software vendor requires in order to integrate with the PPA Portal.



GENERATING YOUR API KEY

1. Log in to the [PPA Portal](#) using the account for which you wish to generate the API Key
2. In the banner menu at the top of the screen, select the **name/profile icon**



3. A drop-down list of options displays. Click on the **Profile** option



4. The *Manage your account* screen displays. Your User ID is visible in the first greyed out field. Click on the **Generate Key** button displayed below.

The pop-up will close and return you to the screen so that the API Key can be copied and saved. Please note you can generate and save a new API Key as required.
